Tasting Notes

The flagship red from Isabelle Carles and Franck Pascal, leaders of the biodynamic renewal in Bergerac. Sourced from clay-limestone vineyards on the Castillon plateau. Vinified naturally with indigenous yeasts, aged 12-18 months in French oak barriques on fine lees. No pumping, no racking, no added sulfites. Powerful yet crunchy—black fruit, spice, leather, with a refreshing chalky tannic grip. Demands decanting or 2-8 years in cellar.

Food Pairings

Pair with roasted beef, duck breast, lasagna, or aged hard cheeses.



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
